- 10. Represent Your School Well-Behave in a way that brings pride to your school.



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- 1. Don't Argue with Judges or Coordinators- Their decision is final and must be respected.
- 2. Don't Use Unfair Means- Avoid cheating, copying, or violating rules.

3. Theme:

 Create a humorous advertisement for a fictional, weird, or exaggerated product or service. The product can be original, imaginary, or a twist on an existing one.

4. Language:

• English or Hindi (bilingual). Content must be school-appropriate and respectful.

5. Props & Costumes:

 Teams must bring their own props and costumes. No harmful or flammable materials allowed.

6. Use of Music:

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 Pre-recorded background music or jingles can be used. Teams must inform the organizers in advance.

7. Preparation Time:

• No preparation time will be given on stage. Teams must be ready before their turn. No green room facility will be provided.

8. Disqualification Clause:

• Use of vulgarity, disrespectful or offensive content will lead to immediate disqualification.

9. Judgement Criteria:

 Creative elements.

- Team Effort & Coordination

- Final edited video should be 1.5 to 3 minutes long.
- Exceeding the limit may lead to disqualification.
- 5. Content Guidelines:

 - No inappropriate content, language, or disrespectful portrayals of school, staff, or students.
 - Student safety must be ensured during shooting (no climbing, racing, etc.).
- 6. Use of Equipment:
 - Mobile phones, DSLRs, or tablets may be used.
 - Students must bring their own devices.
- 7. Editing:
- Basic editing like trimming, background music, text overlays, transitions are allowed.
- Must be done by the students only.
- 8. Submission:
- Final video must be submitted in MP4 format.
- 9. Judgement Criteria:
 - Relevance to Theme
 - Creativity & Originality
 - Visual Appeal & Editing
 - Storytelling/Message
 - Teamwork & Effort
- 10. Judges' Decision: The judges' decision will be final and binding.

Rules & Regulations

- 1. Team Size:
- Minimum 7 students can participate in a group dance category and it should not exceed more than 11 students.
- 2. Time Limit:
- Maximum 4 minutes will be given to the group performance and Additional 1
 minute will be given for presentation, props or stage setting.
- Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- 3. Theme:
- The dance should align with the given theme.
- Props can be used but must be manageable by the team without external help.
- 4. Music:

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- Teams must submit their audio track in MP3 format at least 2 days before the event.
- No live music or singing is allowed during the performance.

5. Costume and Props:

- Costumes must be decent, school-appropriate, and should not hurt any religious or cultural sentiments. Use of hazardous materials or sharp props is strictly prohibited.
- Backdrops, messy props like water and fire may disqualify the team.
- Any form of liquid, gel, aerosol, glitter, etc. that would adversely affect the dancing surface is not allowed to be used.


